DAILY CLEANING

When it comes to cleaning your solid surface countertops, all you need is warm soapy water! You can also opt for an ammonia-based household cleaner or general countertop cleaner to keep your surfaces looking fresh. Any of these cleaning solutions, paired with a microfiber cloth, will be perfect for routine daily cleaning!



CARING FOR STAINS & SPILLS

Be sure to refer to the manufacturer's guidelines for the specific solid surface you own; however, we recommend a few tips:

- Wipe the surface area completely dry after any spills, which will prevent staining and discoloration
- Wet a soft cloth with warm soapy water and clean the area in a circular motion
- To prevent a blotchy appearance, don't allow water or any liquid to sit on top of the surface area for long
- Avoid window cleaners, as they will dull the surface of your countertop



PREVENT DAMAGE

Solid surface countertops can almost always be repaired easily if any damage occurs; however, it's still best to take preventative measures to avoid this possibility. Be sure to refer to the manufacturer's guidelines for the specific solid surface material you own, however, these tips should help guide you:

- Do not place hot pans, pots, or any hot tools directly on your countertop – Be sure to use heat pads whenever needed or allow the product to cool before placing it directly on the surface
- Avoid cutting directly on the countertop material, as this may cause scratches or nicks – Use a cutting board when necessary to prevent this
- If any fine scratches do appear on your solid surface countertop, you can use fine-grain sandpaper to buff them out and call a professional for any deep cuts and cracks
